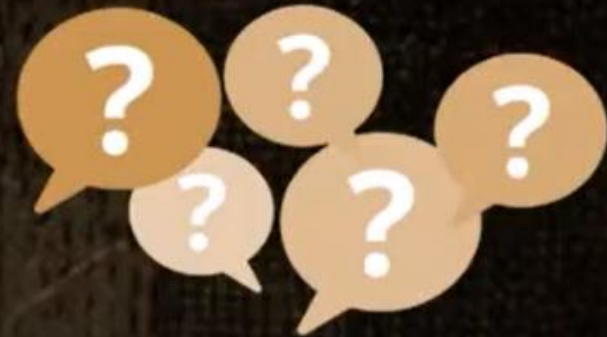




How does the second seed of Jesus' parable relate to the teaching that may or may not be Biblical of 'once saved, always saved'?
